We are currently planning our watershed survey, which as I mentioned in the last e-mail is a walking tour of the watershed in which we look for sources of bacterial contamination. We will divide the watershed into the estuarine portion and the upstream portion. The estuarine portion is scheduled for Wednesday, May 1 (rain date, May 2). If you are interested in helping us assess the shorelands of the estuary on this day, please let us know. We have room for about 10 volunteers. The other sections of the watershed will be scheduled soon. I'll keep you posted.
